#### **ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY APRIL 1:**

This is an annual license and must be purchased each year.

Dog license are valid from January 1 to December 31.

LICENSE RATES ARE:

**Neutered Male & Spayed Female** 

\$3.50

# ANYONE THAT HAS 4 OR MORE DOGS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A KENNEL LICENSE OR MULTIPLE DOG LICENSE

Multiple Dog License (Up to 12) \$36.50

Owners must present their RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE that their dog is vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian before the dog can be licensed. I also need a phone number for Dog license report sent to the Brown County Clerk's Office. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED!!!!!

Curative Connections Transportation Services Rural Expansion – Brown County


