Recycle Center Updates

The Town of Humboldt recently renewed our contract with Harter's Fox Valley Disposal and have changed to new compactors, ensuring less breakdowns and less mess at the center.

We also encourage all residents to recycle, as through our program with Brown County, we receive currently, \$75/ton for our single stream recyclables! This offsets our costs by about 1/2-3/4 currently that we pay to Brown County Port & Resource Recovery.

New Franken Fire and Rescue Updates!

County Rescue recently held an informational meeting seeking out anyone interested in becoming a first responder. There was a great response in attendance both in person and video/zoom viewing. Thank you to all who voiced an interest! County Rescue and the Towns of Humboldt, Green Bay, Scott and Eaton thank you as well.

The New Franken Fire Department has recently purchased a new brush truck, which should arrive later this fall. FYI: the \$100 charge on your property tax bill goes towards capital improvements for the town, which we typically use for our portion of the purchase of new fire trucks and other equipment needed by the fire department.

The fire department responded to 38 calls in the tri Town area last quarter. The first responders in the area responded to about 117 calls in the last quarter.

Grass Cutting of the Town Road Ditches

Our first pass has been completed for the summer. Our second pass will typically begin mid September and complete by end of October. Please help! Clean the ditches of garbage near you.

BROWN COUNTY SOUTH LANDFILL COMMUNITY UPDATE: AFTER A YEAR OF GETTING THE SITE PREPPED FOR CONSTRUCTION, THE BROWN COUNTY SOUTH LANDFILL IS IN FULL BUILDING MODE. THE 26-ACRE CELL HAS BEEN DUG OUT AND CREWS ARE CURRENTLY INSTALLING THE CLAY AND SYNTHETIC LINER. THE CLAY AND SYNTHETIC LINER GO THROUGH HUNDREDS OF TESTS TO ENSURE PROPER CLAY COMPACTION AND SYNTHETIC LINER SEAM SEALING DURING CONSTRUCTION. CREWS ARE WORKING ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RESIDENTIAL DROP OFF AREA AND THE SCALE HOUSE. THE SCALE HOUSE WILL INCLUDE TWO IN-BOUND SCALES AND ROUTINE TRUCKS VISITING THE LANDFILL WILL BE EQUIPPED WITH AN RFID TAG UNIQUE TO EACH VEHICLE. CONSTRUCTION OF A 160,000-GALLON LEACHATE TANK IS ALSO UNDERWAY. THE SOUTH LANDFILL IS ON BUDGET AND ON TASK TO BE READY TO OPEN IN JANUARY 2022.
