PLEASE DO NOT bring grass clippings/leaves to the recycle center. They do not belong in the compactor and we can not burn them. COMPOST is best!

We continue to encourage all residents to recycle, even though the returns have lessened to \$15/ton for our single stream recyclables! Reminder that our hours of operation are from 9 am-1 pm on Saturdays and 4-8 pm on Wednesdays.

Recycling is a big part of what the Town is very active in. At our drop off garbage and recycling center we utilize single stream recycling. Below is a list of those items that can be included!

#1 and #2 plastic containers, Aluminum cans, Steel (tin) cans, Glass bottles and jars, Office paper, Magazines and catalogs, Newspapers, Corrugated cardboard. We also have a barrel for used oil filters, a bunker for scrap metals and a burn pile for clean scrap lumber or brush.
