Construction Update

Utilizing our ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act)money, the Town will begin construction on our storage shed on the Town Hall property this summer. The Town received approximately \$142,000 from the federal government during the covid pandemic to be used for infrastructure improvements, lost wages, or other qualifying expenditures. Part of this money went toward the playground equipment, most will go towards this shed and the remaing will go towards other infrastructure.

NEW ORDINANCE TO REVIEW

CHAPTER 32: RESTRICTING USE & OBSTRUCTION OF TOWN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY DITCHES AND EMBANKMENTS

This ordiance regulates and limits the altering of ditches and the right of way on Town Roads in Humboldt. It also addresses depositing rubbish or yard wastes in any ditch, drain water discharge and structure or construction in the right of way.
