DOG LICENSE

The annual dog tags are in for 2024 and can be purchased at any time.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY APRIL 1: LICENSE RATES ARE FOR EACH DOG:

Male & Female \$8.50

Neutered Male & Spayed Female \$3.50

ANYONE THAT HAS 4 OR MORE DOGS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A KENNEL LICENSE OR MULTIPLE DOG LICENSES:

Multiple Dog License (Up to 12) \$36.50

\$5.00 late fee for dogs licensed after April 1

Owners must present their RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE that their dog is vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian before the dog can be licensed. I also need the Pet Owners phone number for Dog license report sent to the Brown County Clerk's Office. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED!!

Batteries and battery containing devices – especially those containing lithium batteries - are a fire hazard when placed in garbage or recycling. Because of this, the County has created a battery take back program, the Batteries NOW Included program at Brown County Resource Recovery. They take and dispose of household batteries and battery containing devices for free.

These batteries spark fires and the solid waste and transfer stations have had at least 3 fires recently due to batteries. PLEASE recycle or dispose of properly.
