Recycle Center INFO

Used railroad ties are not accepted at our drop off site. They can be brought to the South Landfill site at 1258 Mill Road in **Greenleaf. Because** batteries continue to be fire hazards, be aware about the dangers of putting batteries into the garbage or recycling. The **Brown County Hazardous Material Recovery facility** accepts batteries and certain devices from **Brown County residents** for free.



New Franken Fire and Rescue Updates!

Due to ongoing concerns with space at the New Franken Fire Department site, the 3 Townships in conjuction with the Fire Department have purchased the property next door to the west on E Ronsman Rd. At our annual meeting the people have given the Board the ability to borrow up to \$200,000 if needed for unexpected expenses. Our 1/3 portion is approximately \$192,000, which we plan on borrowing from the Bank of Luxemburg. This loan will be worked into the budget each year just like the loan was when we built the Town Hall.

The Fire Department Run/Walk will be held on September 21, 2024. Check in and registration starts at 7:30 with Run starting at 8:30 am. All proceeds to benefit the New Franken Fire Department.

With the addition of the increased number of new fire fighters, the local list of first responders has also expanded. Welcome to Jason, Cyrus and Sawyer Shikoski, Stacy Bell and Brad Boeke. That makes 12 first responders that may respond to rescue calls in the area, which includes Towns of Humboldt, Eaton, Green Bay and Scott. Thank you to all 11!
