Recycle Center Info

Our hours of operation are from 9 am-1 pm on Saturdays and 4-8 pm on Wednesdays. During the winter, when inclement weather occurs, we will continue to be open unless the temps are extreme and/or winds are high.



TIPS TO RECYCLE CORRECTLY

1. Recycle loosely-that means NO plastic bags of any kind in the recycle compactor. Those include shopping or garbage bags.
2. Empty, rinse and replace covers and caps on jars, bottles, and containers. This helps in the sorting process.
3. Flatten or break down cardboard boxes.
4. Compost all leaves and grass clippings. We accept only clean wood and brush at the drop off site-NO bagged leaves or grass clippings go in the compactor.

BUILDING PERMITS

Any and ALL building of structures needs land use/zoning permit followed by a building permit. This includes moving a building onto your property. Please review chapter 8 of Town ordinances for specifics. To begin the process, please contact the zoning administrator – Norb Dantine at 920-371-7040. The Town’s building inspector is Brett Guillette at 920-495-3232 and MUST be notified prior to construction. Any questions, please contact a board member. Also, if a shed is permitted as “personal use only”, you CANNOT operate a business from that site.

TOWN PROPERTY ASSESSMENT REEVALUATION TO BE DONE IN 2025-2026
